Qualification Criteria

Applicants must:

1. Be a high school senior, graduating at the end of the current school year
2. Be a legal resident of the State of Missouri
3. Be an active and contributing member of their local TSA chapter and state organization
4. Maintain at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA
5. Consistently demonstrate a high level of personal integrity and leadership skills that reflect well personally, on their school, and TSA
6. Robert Stokes Legacy Scholarship requires four years of TSA membership and at least one year serving as a state officer.

Guidelines:

Scholarships can be applied toward a bachelor or associates degree; diploma or certificate program.

Scholarship awards are contingent upon acceptance to a post-secondary institute, awarded as a tuition credit sent directly to the appropriate institution, to be used during the first year of attendance.

Recipients must be enrolled for the summer or fall semester after high school graduation and complete their first year of studies, or be subject to repayment of scholarship.

Tuition scholarships are non-transferable.

Winners will be selected by representatives of MO-TSA Board of Directors at the February Board of Directors meeting.
