MISSOURI LEADERSHIP

TSA allows Missouri's STEM students to take leadership roles at the local, state, and national level.

Each local chapter is led by six officers. Chapter officers work with their local chapter advisor to plan chapter activities, help members prepare for competitions, and organize community service activities.

Students from across the state who wish to serve on the state leadership team campaign to serve on Missouri TSA's 10-member state officer team.

This year Missouri TSA has two students serving on the six-member National TSA Officer Team. Missouri is the only state with more than one National TSA Officer.

Missouri TSA encourages females to take a leadership role in STEM. While over 70% of students in elective STEM courses are male, 50% of Missouri TSA's state officer team are female as are both the National TSA Officers from Missouri.

TSA student leaders are well prepared to become leaders in their career fields.
