



## Missouri TSA Scholarship Application

Current and active high school senior Missouri TSA members that meet the qualification criteria below may apply for a scholarship that will go towards their first year of college. Winners will be announced at the Missouri TSA Championship Conference. The scholarships available are Caleb Crews Memorial Scholarship (\$1,000), Robert Stokes Leadership Scholarship (\$1,000), and two Legacy Scholarships (\$500).

Applicants must submit a completed application, an unofficial transcript, a well written, typed essay, and a letter of recommendation. This letter may be from an administrator, counselor, or teacher in your school district, or from someone in your community who can attest to your leadership qualities (**EXCEPT** your local TSA Advisor). ### Qualification Criteria:

- Be a high school senior, graduating at the end of the current school year
- Be a legal resident of the State of Missouri
- Be an active and contributing member of their local TSA chapter and state organization
- Maintain at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA
- Consistently demonstrate a high level of personal integrity and leadership skills that reflect well personally on their school, and TSA
- Legacy Scholarships require four years of TSA membership and at least one year serving as a state officer.

### Guidelines:

Scholarships can be applied toward a bachelor or associates degree, diploma or certificate program.

Scholarship awards are contingent upon acceptance to a post-secondary institute, awarded as a tuition credit sent directly to the appropriate institution, to be used during the first year of attendance.

Recipients must be enrolled for the summer or fall semester after high school graduation and complete their first year of studies or be subject to repayment of scholarship.

Tuition scholarships are non-transferable.
